“CORNUCOPIA” - a 10 month **Block of the Month** by **Tucker University** using Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Design **Tucker Trimmer 1, Wing Clipper 1, Square Squared, Corner Pop 1** and **Diamond Rects** tools.

Supply List

- Pattern - **Cornucopia** (will be provided first day of class)
- Studio 180 Design tools - **Tucker Trimmer 1, Wing Clipper 1, Square Squared, Diamond Rects, Corner Pop 1, Quilter's Magic Wand.** (You will need the Tucker Trimmer 1, Wing Clipper 1 and Diamond Rect tools for the 1st class)
- Paper plates - dinner size - 8.5" - 10" to help with organization
- 1" or 1 1/2" Loose leaf binder and 25 page protectors to hold pattern
- Quart size and gallon size zip lock storage bags - helps with organization

Basic Sewing and Quilting Supplies -

- Sewing Machine with a new needle (**70/10 needle for batiks** or **80/12 for cotton**), power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 or 60 wt is good for piecing
- Seam ripper
- Scissor snips
- Extra fine pins - Clover Patchwork Extra Fine Pins Or Magic Pins - extra fine for precision pinning.
- Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Small cutting mat - 12" x 12" or larger
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixion pen or marking pencil such as Sewline)
- Straight edge ruler 4.5" x 8.5" or larger
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for for back of tools to prevent slipping

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: The Value of each fabric is listed in the chart below and the number shows which block it is used in.

Fabric F (Dark) 1,12 (Medium) 3	1 Fat Quarter	Fabric R (Dark) 5, 6, 13	1/2 yard
Fabric G (Medium) 5,13	1 Fat Quarter	Fabric S (Dark) 4, 9, 14, 20	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric H (Medium) 10 (Light) 16	1/2 yard	Fabric T (Medium) 1, 18	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric J (Medium) 7 (Dark) 16	1 Fat Quarter	Fabric U (Light) 3	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric K (Medium) 9,15	1 Fat Quarter	Fabric V (Dark) 2 (Medium) 4, 14, 17	1/2 yard

Fabric Selection Guidance

*You will need a total of **2 Lights, 2 Lights Mediums** (Fabric H and N are used as both a Light and a Medium in different blocks), **6 Medium, 4 Medium Darks** (Fabric D, Fabric F, Fabric J, Fabric V are used as both a Medium and a Dark in different blocks), **5 Darks, a Background Fabric (Fabric A) and Darker Background Fabric (Fabric Q)***

Cornucopia Connector Block will use Fabric A (background), Fabric H (Light Medium), Fabric O (Medium), Fabric V (Medium Dark) (will be Geese on the Edge); Fabric R (Dark) (center square for Square Squared) Fabric N (Medium) (will be Half Square Triangle and Corner Popped Log)
