

## Little Butterflies

### Supplies List

- Pattern: **Little Butterflies by Edyta Sitar**
- **Little Butterflies** stencil for cutting butterfly applique pieces (optional—I didn't use it for my sample)
- Charm squares for butterfly parts (12-24) You may also use yardage, if you prefer.
- Charm squares (or yardage) for block backgrounds
- Fusible interfacing (the type that has a paper backing- I used Heat and Bond lite)
- Thread for applique. I used invisible thread with a 60 weight bobbin thread. You may also choose to use thread that matches the colors of the fabrics you're using for the butterfly appliques.
- Microtex or Topstitch machine needle size 70 or 80 for applique
- Small scissors for cutting out appliques
- Thread for piecing
- Pen/pencil for marking the applique patterns
- Paper cutting scissors
- General sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, rulers

Note: If you feel confident in cutting, it's a good idea to cut some or all the applique pieces out before class. Follow the cutting instructions given in the pattern.
