

## BERNINA Embroidery Club – August 2025

### Quilted Zipper Pouch Supply List



During this class we will create a quilting pattern from a sewing stitch. We will then add an embroidered embellishment, zipper, and lining while creating a quilted pouch in the hoop.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. Regarding fabric choice, cotton fabric works best. The pouch can be made in two different sizes, depending on which hoop is used.

#### Fabric for Exterior: (sample is blue)

	<u>Large Oval</u>	<u>Midi</u>
Front top panel	1 – 7 ½" x 2 ½". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 7 ½" x 1 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 3". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 8 ½" x 1 ½".
Front bottom panel	1 – 7 ½" x 8 ½". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 7 ½" x 4 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 9". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 8 ½" x 4 ½".
Back	1 – 7 ½" x 5 ½".	1 – 8 ½" x 6 ½".

#### Fabric for Lining: (sample is flowered, inside of pouch)

	<u>Large Oval</u>	<u>Midi</u>
Front top panel	1 – 7 ½" x 2 ½". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 7 ½" x 1 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 3". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 8 ½" x 1 ½".
Front bottom panel	1 – 7 ½" x 8 ½". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 7 ½" x 4 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 9". Press in half (wrong sides together) to make 8 ½" x 4 ½".
Back	1 – 7 ½" x 5 ½".	1 – 8 ½" x 6 ½".

**OESD Fusible Woven:**

	<u>Large Oval</u>	<u>Midi</u>
Front top panel	1 – 7 ½" x 1 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 1 ½".
Front bottom panel	1 – 7 ½" x 4 ¼".	1 – 8 ½" x 4 ½".
Back	1 – 7 ½" x 5 ½".	1 – 8 ½" x 6 ½".

**OESD Medium Weight Tear Away Stabilizer:** 1 – to fit the hoop you're using

**Zipper:** 1 – 10" polyester or nylon, color to match your exterior fabric. Sample is blue.

**Threads:**

- Isacord – Threads to match the exterior and lining fabrics. Total two colors.
- Isacord – Thread to quilt. This may coordinate or contrast with your exterior fabric. Your choice.
- Isacord – Thread for the embroidered embellishment.
- Bobbin – Seraline embroidery bobbin thread and thread to match the lining.

**Lite Steam-A-Seam 2** – ¼" x 6", or you can hand stitch it shut. Your choice.

**Needle** – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12

**Embroidery machine** – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

**Feet** - #26 (embroidery)

**Hoop** – Large Oval or Midi. You can make both size pouches in the Midi. Only the smaller pouch fits in the Large Oval.

**Stitch plate** – single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

**Other:**

OESD Expert Point and Press Tool or your favorite tool to turn corners  
Painter's tape or OESD Tape Tear Away  
Pins  
Thread snips  
Tweezers  
Fabric scissors  
Rotary cutter  
Flash drive (USB stick)
