

## **BERNINA** Embroidery Club – October 2025 Tiling Scene Starter 2 Supply List



Although beautiful, tiling scenes intimidate many that have not created one. During this class we will remove the intimidation by embroidering four tiles from the Modern Petals tiling scene to create a 10" x 10" wall hanging. This is one-quarter of the full tiling scene.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. Regarding fabric choice, quilting cotton works best.

### **Fabric:**

- 4 pieces of non-designed cotton fabric, each 7 ½" x 7 ½" for tiles. (Sample is gray, purple, peach, and tan)
- 18" square cotton fabric for backing. A fat quarter will work fine. This will allow enough for the corners on the back to make a hanger.
- 2 ½" x WOF (width of fabric) for binding. Choose a color to coordinate with the thread or fabric.

**Batting** – 12" x 12" low to medium loft batting. The Old Country Store usually has remnants for sale if you don't have any.

### **Stabilizers:**

- OESD Fuse and Fleece, 4 pieces 7 ½" x 7 ½". Adhere to the back of the tile fabric pieces.
- OESD Ultra Clean & Tear Away or Medium Weight Tear Away. You will need enough for four hoopings.

### **Bobbin Thread:**

- Seraline bobbin thread

- Isacord thread to match the backing fabric
- Isacord thread different from the threads listed below for the seam stitch around the block. You want to know which is the seam stitch when measuring to cut.

#### **Isacord Thread:**

- Thread to match your tiling fabric if your four fabrics are close in color. Otherwise you should use invisible thread to stitch in the ditch (Sample used MonoPoly invisible thread). Bring your thread net if you want to use invisible thread. A thread net came with your machine.
- Thread for the tiles. The following six colors are used on the tiles: 101 (eggshell), 152 (dolphin), 822 (palomino), 1332 (harvest), 3654 (blue shadow), and 4111 (turquoise). Of course you can use threads you already have if you so choose.

**Needle** – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12.

**Embroidery machine** – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

**Feet** - #26 (embroidery), #10/10D (edge stitch foot), #20 (open toe), and ¼” foot (37/57/97), preferably dual feed, if you have one. If you have a walking foot, that may be helpful to stitch through the tiles.

**Hoop** – Large Oval or Midi.

**Stitch plate** – single-hole 0mm (if you have one) and regular.
