

Basket Case Student Supply List

Pattern:

Basket Case pattern by Cluck Cluck Sew

Fabric Requirements (as listed on pattern):

Material Requirements:

	Crib 40" x 50"	Throw (Cover Quilt) 60" x 70"	Twin 70" x 90"	Queen 90" x 90"	King 110" x 90"
Print fabrics*	20 precut 2 ½" strips	42 precut 2 ½" strips or 14 assorted ¼ yards	63 precut 2 ½" strips or 16 assorted ⅓ yards	81 precut 2 ½" strips or 21 assorted ⅓ yards	99 precut 2 ½" strips or 15 assorted ½ yards
White fabric	1 yard	1 ¾ yards	2 ¾ yards	3 ¼ yards	4 yards
Backing	2 ¾ yards**	4 yards	5 ½ yards	8 ¼ yards	8 ¼ yards
Binding	½ yard	½ yard	¾ yard	1 yard	1 yard

* Pre-cut strips need to be the width of the fabric, approximately 42". A jelly roll has approx. 40 strips, so to make the throw size for example, you will need an extra ¼ yard cut into 3 strips, in addition to the jelly roll. Because there are some fabrics you might not want to use in the jelly roll I recommend buying one or two coordinating ¼ yards to cut into strips.

** 1 ½ yards will also work but will leave you with only 1-3" around the edges of the quilt top.

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric Shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers; I like the following sizes:
 - 6" x 24"
 - 4" x 14"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in working order
- ¼" patchwork foot, if you have
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 sharp or universal

Additional Supplies:

- 15" Mini Design Board to lay out your fabrics
- Lint roller for those jelly roll fuzzies!

Ironing Supplies:

- The classroom is well equipped with ironing stations, but you may wish to bring a small iron and pressing mat for your workstation.
- Wooly Pressing Bar or strip stick for pressing seams open

Please cut your background fabric into 2-1/2" squares as directed in the pattern prior to class. A Stripology ruler is handy for the subcuts if you have one.

This is a fun block – looking forward to stitching it with you!
