

Digitized and Embroidered Custom Quilt

Thank you for joining me for the **Digitized and Embroidered Custom Quilt** classes, where we'll explore the basics of Bernina Software 9 and create stunning embroidery projects! This class is perfect for those looking to expand their skills in digitizing and manipulating designs from the OESD Caravan Collection. Over eight months, dedicating 4 hours each session to both software techniques and practice stitch outs. You'll master techniques such as stump work, applique, resizing, all while creating a beautiful sampler quilt. This interactive class allows you to ask questions and share your progress with fellow students. By the end, you'll have a thorough understanding of digitizing designs and using different stabilizers, ready to take your embroidery to the next level!

Supply List

Software:

Bernina Software 9 installed onto your computer

Please have all designs saved onto your computer before class.

Designs:

For this class I chose the Caravan Collection from OESD.

You can find it here. [Caravan \(oesd.com\)](http://oesd.com)

Fabric:

I used fabric from my scraps to complete this Sampler.

(12) 12"x12" blocks

(2) 12"x 22" blocks

(3) 2" x 40" Sashings

(2) 2" x 44" Side Borders

(2) 2" x 44" Top Borders

(4) scraps of fabric to use for practice

(2) 8" x 8" scrap pieces of clear vinyl

Extra fabric in case you make a mistake here or there

(Scraps of threads and fabric that you would normally trash) We will use this to make our confetti blocks.)

Please note: There is no pattern to buy. I would suggest not cutting out your sashings and borders until you have completed your blocks.

Rulers

6 inches with metric included

10 ½ square ruler or bigger to size blocks **after** embroidery is completed

24 inch cutting ruler to cut fabric to size

Thread:**For Embroidery:**

Have on hand a variety of threads that you plan on using for your design. Look at the color chart that goes with the design chosen. Have fun mixing and matching different colors to make it your own.

You will need 11 colors for this sampler quilt.

You will need:

(suggested colors)

3 different shades of gray

1 blue

1 off white

3 tans

1 metallic

2 red

Additional Thread

You will need 1 Razzle thread for couching

You will need 1 Dazzle Thread by wonderful 8wt

For Sewing:

I used a light gray Ariful for all piecing.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread rewound

Bobbin Case:

- If you have a yellow bobbin case it is highly recommended that you use this when embroidering
- You will also be using your black bobbin case for the sewing portion of this project.

Stabilizers:

(I used all OESD stabilizers)

Light weight

Medium weight

Hydro Stick

Ultra Clean and Tear

Fusible Woven

PolyMesh

Hoops:

Large hoop

Midi hoop

Maxi hoop

Clamp hoop (optional)

If you only have the large hoop, don't stress, you will design your designs to fit the hoop you currently have.

Needles: -

- Schmetz Microtex 80/12
- Schmetz Ball Point 80/12
- Hemstitch 120/19

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

Needed for Digitized classes

- **Feet:** - #26 (embroidery foot)
- **Feet:** - # 97, 97C, 97D (1/4 inch foot)
- **Thread-lubrication unit**

Needed or optional embellishment classes

- **Feet:** - #10, 10C, 10D (Edge Stitch Foot) optional
- **Feet:** - #20, 20C, 20D (Open Toe Foot)
- **Foot:** - #25 (Couching Foot)
- **Feet:** - #34C (Pattern Foot) (This foot is optional) (You can use #20 foot when I use this one)
- **Feet:** - #25 5 (groove couching foot)
- **Feet:** - Eyelet Tool Attachment #82 with foot #92 (This is optional – only if you want to make the different sizes with your eyelets. You have an eyelet built into your machine in the button section of your tools #62. I suggest you take a peek there before you buy the eyelet tool.)
 - Please note: You do not need all of these feet at the beginning of class. They are needed for the optional embellishment classes if you choose to attend. More details on this class later to come.

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) and regular 9mm

Other supplies recommended:

Small old towel or drop cloth

Thread snips

small and large ruler

Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins

Fabric scissors

Your machine manual

Paper for taking notes

Soldering tool (optional)

Terrial Magic or Best Press

Water-soluble or Heat Vanishing marking pen

Air Temporary Marker

Tweezers

paper scissors

rotary cutter

small applique scissors

seam ripper

press cloth

embroidery tape

X-Acto knife (optional)
