

## Travel Case for Mini Iron Class

### Supply List

- Travel Case for Mini Iron Pattern by Minki Kim
  - If you are purchasing a PDF version of the pattern, please make sure you follow the printing instructions listed in the pattern so that the templates print to the correct size.
- Fabric A – 1 Fat Quarter Quilting Cotton
- Fabric B- 1 Fat Quarter Quilting Cotton
- Lining Fabric – ½ yd Quilting Cotton
  - Directional fabrics may require more yardage
  - You can also mix and match with more fabric combinations more if you choose
- ½ yd byAnnie's Soft & Stable foam stabilizer
- 22" nylon teeth double pull Zipper
  - (such as #5 Zipper by the Yard or byAnnie's #4.5 handbag zipper)
- 8" piece of 1" wide webbing
- Coordinating Polyester Thread
- Rotary cutter
- Long Ruler for cutting
- Pins
- Fabric Clips (helpful to hold thick foam and binding in place)
- Roxanne's Basting Glue
- Seam Ripper
- Fabric scissors
- Clover Bias tape maker ¾" (optional but helpful)
- Stiletto (optional but helpful)
- Tailors Chalk (if using dark fabrics)
- Disappearing ink pen for marking on fabric
- 90/14 sewing machine needle
- If you are bringing your sewing machine with you to use, please remember to bring your zipper foot attachment.

### Before Class:

Please have your fabric pressed and cut per the cutting instructions at the very beginning of the pattern. Please cut your foam as well. We will begin the class with the minimal quilting necessary for the top and bottom pieces of the iron case.
