

BERNINA Embroidery Club – November 2025 Quilt Label Supply List



Learn an easy way to create quilt labels in the hoop. The design options are almost endless. You can embellish with most any design, leave it blank to hand write, stitch lines to write, or embroider the words. All these choices and the raw edges are enclosed. Time to get labels on your quilts!

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. Regarding fabric choice, quilting cotton works best. There will be time to make two labels so supply list includes enough to make two.

Fabric:

- 2 pieces of cotton fabric, each 6" x 8" (sample is white).

Stabilizers:

- OESD Polymesh – 4 pieces for your hoop.
- OESD Polymesh – 2 pieces, each 6" x 8".

Bobbin Thread:

- Seraline bobbin thread

Isacord Thread:

- Bring threads from your stash to stitch the designs. If you want to know the threads used in the samples, they are listed below.
- Leaves design – white 0015, gold 0721, blue 4620, green 0352, gray 0152, and tan 0672.
- Loop design – white 0015, yellow 0640, purple 3045, orange 0811, pink 1840, blue 4240, and outlines 0132.

Needle – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12.

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

Feet - #26 (embroidery)

Hoop – Large Oval or Midi, your choice.

Stitch plate – single-hole 0mm (if you have one).

Other:

Ruler

Rotary cutter

Thread snips

Tweezers

Fabric scissors

Turning tool (what you use to push out corners)
