

Winter Trio Class Supply List

Pattern by Laundry Basket Quilts available at The Old Country Store (OCS)

Consists of 3 different table runners. We will make the 'Snowman' runner.
The Snowman runner as shown in the pattern with a border as shown in the sample.

1 fat quarter for background OR a 1/2 yard of a light background (for borderLESS) that will compliment your snowman fabric choices.

Assortment of 12 inch squares or your choice of fabrics for the snowman applique—I used batiks. A square each for a hat, snowman (2 squares), carrot nose, eyes and hat (1 piece), scarf (3 squares) and snowflakes if not purchasing the silhouettes.

*The snowflakes can be purchased in a pack of fusible silhouettes at OCS and the small ones in the pack are what was used in the sample runner.

*The border was added and the instructions are not included in the pattern but will be provided in class. For a pieced border an assortment of cotton and batik fabric of 2.5 inch squares (132 squares) are needed. Consider using charm packs or mini charm packs.

3/4 of a yard of fusible webbing for applique such as 18 inch wide Lite Steam a Seam 2 available at OCS.

Batting- 1 yard or 1/2 a yard for a runner WITHOUT A BORDER. Consider the Batting Bits @ OCS.

Backing- 1 yard or 1/2 of a yard for a runner WITHOUT A BORDER.

1/3 of a yard for binding for the pieced border runner. 1/4 of a yard for the runner WITHOUT a border (as shown on pattern cover).

Thread—choose a thread that will compliment your fabrics and consider variegated thread. You may also use several colors for the fusible applique and quilting if you wish or one neutral color. Thread for piecing. 50 wt for both.

A pair of scissors for cutting out applique. I prefer KAI scissors sold at OCS.

Extra sewing notions that will be helpful include a pressing sheet or pressing cloth, pins or clips for piecing and a pen or pencil for tracing. Rotary cutter, ruler, and iron if you prefer to bring your own. Also, a light box is nice and convenient for tracing, but not required.
