Embroidery Design Requirement

Before class, please purchase an embroidery design collection of your choice. I recommend selecting from **OESD** (Oklahoma Embroidery Supply & Design) or another trusted embroidery company.

Design Guidelines:

- Choose a theme that inspires you — animals, florals, storybook characters, or seasonal designs.
- Each design should fit comfortably within a **5" x 7" embroidery area** (large hoop size).
- Bring your designs preloaded on a **USB stick** ready for class.
- Avoid oversized or dense stitch designs that may distort the fabric.

Fabric Requirements

All fabric must be 100% quilting cotton, unwashed (*this helps maintain consistency when sewing fabrics*).

- 9 or 10 (1/4) yards of different colors for the “wonky” part of your quilt (fat quarters and scraps would work for this part of your quilt work)
- 2 yards of muslin
- Background: 4 yards
- Backing: 3 yards
- Binding: 3/4 yard

You will have extra fabric. This is so you have choices when making the color selection when sewing

There's no prep work required before class — all cutting and measuring will be done together during our sessions. The only work done at home will be the homework assignments between classes.

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Tools to Bring

- Rotary cutter
- Quilting rulers: 6.5"x24" optional: one larger than a 12" square
- Pins or clips
- Seam ripper
- Marking tools (Sew Line pen, chalk pencil, etc.)
- Thread snips
- Microtex needle 80/12
- Stabilizer
 - Ultra Clean and Tear 10 or 20 inch will work – bring your whole roll
 - Medium Tear away 10 inch – bring your whole roll
 - Light Tear away 10 inch – bring your whole roll
 - 505 spray
 - Terial Magic spray
- Paper scissors
- Pressing supplies: small iron and pressing mat
- Teflon pressing sheet

Thread

- Aurifil thread in cream or gray (recommended for piecing)
- Bobbin pre-wound with Seralene thread for embroidery
- Several embroidery thread colors to match your selected designs – I would suggest you look at the colors on the color chart from the selected designs
- Optional: metallic or variegated thread for embellishments.

Machine Setup

- Machines can be provided, but attendees are encouraged to bring their own.
- Preferred setup includes: sewing machine with table, module, cords, foot control, and manual.
- Bring embroidery hoops and templates for your selected design size.
- If borrowing a classroom machine, please bring your own USB stick with your embroidery files loaded.
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- **Bernina presser feet:** #97, 97C, or 97D - #71 - #26

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- If using another brand, choose a ¼” foot you’re comfortable with and the embroidery foot
- **Bernina stitch plate:** single hole 0mm (if available) or regular 9mm.
- Temporary fabric marker or pencil.
- Be prepared to thread your own machine.

Suggested Extras

- Notebook or printed paper for demo notes.
- Light snack or beverage.
