

## Atlas Zipper Case Student Supply List

**Pattern:** You will need to purchase the *Atlas Zipper Case* pattern – available as a PDF download from Center Street Quilts Etsy shop or as a paper pattern from The Old Country Store.

**Fabric & Notions:** as listed in pattern:

### Supply Requirements

Atlas Zipper Case  
Finished Size: 8" x 10" when closed, 16" x 10" when open

Main Fabric *	Fat Quarter
Accent Fabric	Fat Quarter
Lining Fabric	1/2 Yard
Binding Fabric	1/2 Yard
Foam Stabilizer** or Batting	(1) 18" x 24" piece
Vinyl (12 or 16 gauge recommended)	(1) 10" x 15" piece
Zippers ***	(1) 30" Zipper (3) 10" Zippers

\* Directional prints may require more fabric for the Main Fabric.

\*\* Foam Stabilizer such as Soft and Stable or Pellon Flex-Foam.

\*\*\* All zippers can be longer than measurements given and cut down to size if needed. A larger #5 size zipper is recommended for the 30" zipper. Either #5 or standard #3 size zippers can be used for the 10" zippers. Nylon (plastic) zippers are recommended over metal zippers.

**Zipper info:** Be sure to select a zipper that can be shortened with scissors or a rotary cutter. Metal zippers or molded plastic parka zippers cannot be shortened. (Note: I used #5 zippers by the yard for all my zippers.)

#### Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric: Aurifil 50 wt works well for machine quilting the body of the pouch, but I prefer a stronger thread for the actual bag construction. Superior So Fine or a polyester thread are good options.
- Strong Pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

- Utility scissors for cutting zippers

### **Sewing Machine, etc.**

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" piecing foot
- Zipper foot
- Overcast foot or a foot that will allow you to stitch a zig zag stitch
- Teflon foot if you have
- 90/14 Denim or Topstitch needle

### **Rotary Cutting Supplies**

- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers - my favorite sizes:
  - 4" x 14"
  - 6" x 24"

### **Misc Tools & Notions**

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only!) or hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Marking pen or pencil
- Roxanne's Glue-Baste-It (I prefer the EZ-Squeezie bottle)

### **Optional Supplies:**

- Machine quilting gloves
- ½" bias tape maker for making fabric zipper pulls
- ¼" basting tape

### **Additional Notes:**

- Please cut your fabrics prior to class using the chart on p. 3 of the pattern, *with the exception of the bias binding* – I have a preferred cutting method that I like to show you that minimizes seams. Also, be mindful of your fabric orientation if using directional prints.
- If you are comfortable with quilting your fabrics ahead of time, feel free to do so. I like to use a stitch length of 3.0 for my quilting.
