

# Technique for using Endless Embroidery

## Supply list:

### Digitize Design

- **Custom Class Details**
  - This class will use a specific OESD embroidery design for instructional purposes. Please purchase this design prior to class. While this design may not reflect everyone's personal style, using a common design allows the entire class to focus on technique, problem-solving, and decision-making together. Working from the same design creates a consistent learning environment and supports deeper understanding of the concepts taught.

    - Please bring one purchased border pattern of your choice. I would suggest no more than 3 or 4 color changes and no more than 3 – 4 inches in height.
      - Have this pattern on a flash drive, where you can find it easily for use in class.

### Fabric

- 1 yard scrappy fabric – cut into the sizes below – First day
  - 12 x WOF (WOF = Width of Fabric)
- 1 yard scrappy fabric – Cut into the sizes below – Second day
  - 12 x WOF (WOF = Width of Fabric)

### Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Light tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.

### Thread

- Bring a variety of threads that match the colors of your desired design.

### Bobbin Thread:

- **We will be using our black bobbin case.**
- Have a bobbin prewound with the colors used for your design.

**Needles:** - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 80/14. *I recommend the Microtex 80/14.*

**Embroidery Machine:** – bring all items to make your machine work 😊

**Feet:** - #26 (embroidery foot)

### Hoop:

- large hoop or the largest hoop you have available
- I highly recommend a magnetic hoop – I used the new Bernina Medium Border Hoop

**Stitch plate:** Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

**Pattern:** Please print out and bring to class if you are planning on making an embroidered pillow. Not needed if you are not. We will not be completing a pillow in class. As this is only a technical class.
