

Dancing Umbrella Class Supply List

Pattern: Dancing Umbrella by Laundry Basket Quilts/Edyta Sitar

Dancing Umbrella Stencil (LBQ-0344-TP)

Fabric requirements:

***Small nine block scrappy wall hanging (approximately 28 x 28)

Nine - 10 inch squares of light blocks for the backgrounds

Nine - 10 inch squares of assorted colors for the umbrellas that can be mixed and matched plus extra pieces, if desired, for a scrappy look

Binding: 1/4 yard

Batting: 30 x 30

Backing: 31 x 31

3/4 yard of Heat and Bond Lite (no substitute)

***Large Umbrella Quilt as shown on pattern cover - approximately 45 x 54 ~ 30 blocks

2 yards of Heat and Bond Lite

30–10" x 10" squares in medium and dark fabrics for the umbrellas —consider a Layer Cake

A variety of THIRTY—10 inch light blocks or background colors of your choice.

Binding: .5 yards

Backing: 3 yards

Thread: Consider different colors for appliquéing each umbrella, neutral thread for piecing

***Schmetz Super Nonstick Needles for both size quilts from the OCS

***An appliqué foot for the sewing machine is recommended to help clearly see the edges of the design that is being appliquéed.

Sharp scissors for cutting out fused appliquéés. I prefer KAI scissors sold at the OCS.

Extra sewing notions that will be helpful include pins for piecing and a pen or pencil for tracing. A rotary cutter and ruler to cut your background fabrics and an iron if you prefer to bring your own, especially for fusing.
