

## Supply List For "Home of the Red, White and Blue"

### **Basic Sewing Supplies:**

- \*\* Sewing machine
- \*\* Sewing machine needles
- \*\* Scissors/thread snips
- \*\* Neutral thread to match fabric
- \*\* Red thread if NEW to paper piecing
- \*\* Iron and pressing mat
- \*\* Open toe foot is recommended, but patchwork foot will also work

### **Rotary Cutting Supplies:**

- \*\* Rotary cutter with new blade
- \*\* Cutting mat - 18" X 24" is ideal
- \*\* 3 ½" X 12" ruler or similar size for general cutting

### **Additional supplies:**

- \*\* Add A Quarter Ruler
- \*\* Glue pen - Sewline glue pen works well
- \*\* 12 gallon size & 4 quart size plastic storage bags - for organizing
- \*\* Clips, sturdy pins or large paper clips - for organizing

\*\*\* Paper piece pattern will be provided on the day of class \*\*\*

### **Fabric Requirements:**

- \*\* ¼ yards of 10-12 different blue fabrics for variety
- \*\* ¼ yards of 10-12 different white or cream fabrics for variety
- \*\* 2 different red fabrics:
  - ¼ yard for the center squares
  - 1 yard for inside triangles

### **Required Fabric Cutting Before Class:**

Once you have signed up for the class, please email me and I will send you detailed charts and instructions to precut all your fabric before class.

There are 64 total 7" blocks in this quilt measuring 56" X 56"
