

Yankee Doodle Dandy Supply List

Pattern:

Yankee Doodle Dandy quilt pattern by Holly Lesue, available as a paper pattern or PDF download from Maker Valley:

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Additional Supplies:

- Frixion pen or fine tip fabric marking pencil and small ruler for drawing diagonal lines on your fabric squares, OR
- Cluck Cluck Sew Diagonal Seam Tape

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic ruler
- Cutting mat

Ironing Supplies:

The classroom is well equipped with ironing stations, but you may wish to bring a small iron and pressing mat for your workstation. My favorite pressing boards will be available for sale during class (cash, check, or Venmo).

Sewing Machine, etc:

- Sewing machine in working order
- 1/4" patchwork foot
- Sewing machine needles

Fabric Requirements (see pattern)

Part of the fun of this quilt is collecting a variety of fabrics to make it scrappy. Feel free to bring extra 5" squares/fabric (red & blue) as well as low volume fabrics to swap or sell to other students. Also, be sure to bring some cash (quarters and \$1.00 bills) in case you wish to sell/purchase 5" squares. I am thinking we can charge \$.25 for a 5" square of fabric. 😊

We'll plan to work on the blue star field during class, so be sure to cut the blue 5" squares (48) and the low volume 3" squares (48) prior to class.
