

Collage Quilt Supply List

- Pattern: “Teeny Tiny Collage Patterns by Laura Heine-Group #5 Pincushion, Dress Form and Sewing Machine” (I made the Sewing Machine)

Note: I selected this pattern because it is smaller than Laura’s regular size designs, therefore you will have a better chance of completing the top in class. However, if you already have another Laura Heine pattern that you would like to use, you may bring that to class. I will be teaching the techniques that can be applied to any collage quilt. Should you decide to do this, please be sure to check the supply list for the pattern you are using.

- Good selection of scraps for backgrounds and cuttables

Note: I will be bringing along my collection of scraps. Feel free to bring a lot of your scraps to share.

- 19” x 23” piece of Pattern Ease foundation
- 3 yards of 12” wide Steam a Seam 2 lite
- #2 pencil
- Small scissors for cutting out designs from fabric
- Goddess applique Pressing sheet 17” x 24” or Precision Fusing Mat 17” x 24”
- Small rotary cutter, mat, and ruler (3” x 12”)
- 2/3 yards of backing fabric
- Batting
- General sewing supplies including thread that you would like to use for quilting
- Small iron for your workplace (OPTIONAL)
- Masking tape
