- **Petite Rapid Fire Hunter Star and Four Patch Square Up tools by Studio 180 Design** (Available at the OCS)

Basic Sewing and Quilting Supplies -

- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot, a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Seam ripper
- Scissor snips
- Extra fine pins - Clover Patchwork Extra Fine Pins or Magic Pins - extra fine
- Small cutting mat - 12" x 12" or larger
- Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixion pen or marking pencil such as Sewline)
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for back of tools
- RULER - 3" x 12", 3" x 18" **OR** 6" x 12"

Fabric Yardage:

Based on 42" of useable fabric. WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabric 4 (Rust)	5/8 yard	1 yard	1 3/8 yards
Fabric 5 (Dark Brown)	5/8 yard	1 yard	1 3/8 yards
Fabric 6 (Dark Brown)	1/2 yard	5/8 yard	1 1/8 yards
Fabric 7 (Border)	3/4 yard	7/8 yard	1 1/8 yards
Binding	1/2 yard	5/8 yard	7/8 yard
Backing	3 5/8 yards	5 yards	8 5/8 yards

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric	Piece	Lap	Twin	Queen
Fabric 1 (Light Tan) Background	Hunter Star Blocks (Oversized Triangles)	Cut (7) Strips 6" x WOF, sub cut into (40) 6" squares, then cut diagonally once to make (80) triangles	Cut (10) Strips 6" x WOF, sub cut into (60) 6" squares, then cut diagonally once to make (120) triangles	Cut (19) Strips 6" x WOF, sub cut into (112) 6" squares, then cut diagonally once to make (224) triangles
	Squares	Cut (3) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (20) 4 1/2" squares	Cut (4) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (30) 4 1/2" squares	Cut (7) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (56) 4 1/2" squares
	Time Out (Strips A)	Cut (4) Strips 2 3/4" x WOF	Cut (6) Strips 2 3/4" x WOF	Cut (12) Strips 2 3/4" x WOF
	Border 1	Cut (6) Strips 2" x WOF	Cut (8) Strips 2 1/2" x WOF	Cut (9) Strips 2 1/2" x WOF
Fabric 2 (Medium Tan)	Hunter Star Blocks (Trapezoid Strips)	Cut (10) strips 1 3/4" x WOF	Cut (15) strips x 1 3/4" x WOF	Cut (28) strips x 1 3/4" x WOF
Fabric 3 (Medium Brown)	Squares	Cut (2) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (10) 4 1/2" squares	Cut (2) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (15) 4 1/2" squares	Cut (4) strips 4 1/2" x WOF, sub cut into (28) 4 1/2" squares
	Hunter Star Blocks (Star Point Strips)	Cut (7) strips 2 1/4" x WOF	Cut (10) strips 2 1/4" x WOF	Cut (19) strips 2 1/4" x WOF
Fabric 4 (Rust)	Time Out (Strips B & C)	Cut (6) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (2) strip B and (4) strip C	Cut (9) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (3) strip B and (6) strip C	Cut (17) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (6) strip B and (11) strip C
Fabric 5 (Dark Brown 1)	Time Out. (Strips B & C)	Cut (6) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (2) strip B and (4) strip C	Cut (9) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (3) strip B and (6) strip C	Cut (17) strips 2 3/4" x WOF Divide the strips into 2 stacks and label (6) strip B and (11) strip C
Fabric 6 (Dark Brown 2)	Hunter Star Blocks (Star Point Strips)	Cut (7) strips 2 1/4" x WOF	Cut (10) strips 2 1/4" x WOF	Cut (19) strips 2 1/4" x WOF
Fabric 7 (Border 2)	Border 2	Cut (6) strips 3 1/2" x WOF	Cut (8) strips 3 1/2" x WOF	Cut (10) strips 4 1/2" x WOF

Getting Organized!!! Separate above fabrics into units onto paper plates or in to ziplock bags and label -

Hunter Star Blocks - Fabric 1 - Oversized triangles, Fabric 2 - Trapezoid strips, Fabric 3 - Star Point Strips, Fabric 6 - Star Point Strips

Time Out Units - Fabric 1 - Strips A, Fabric 4 - Strips B & C, Fabric 5 - Strips B & C

Squares - Fabric 1, Fabric 3
